



Busy Bee Analog Clock






Cut along the dashed lines. Minutes Strip Hour Strip 00 **05** 03 04 20 <u>30</u> 08 **35** 40 Extra hands: 45 **50** <u>55</u>

Instructions

- 1) With scissors or an X-Acto knife, make slits along the 4 dashed lines under the hour and minute slots. See red arrows.
- 2) Cut out the two number strips and hands on the second page. Hole punch the hands.
- 3) Using a paper fastener, poke a hole in the center of the clock. Fasten the hands with the fastener making sure the hour hand is on top of the minute hand.
- 4) Slide the hour strip through the 2 slots so that only the hour shows. Same with the minute strip.
- 5) Now it's ready to use for games, assignments and activity centers!
